



Pesticide Statement in Cannabis Production Information

YAVA DBA WAM Oil company implements an integrated pest management program that follows the Washington State Department of Agriculture acceptable practices for the cultivation of cannabis flower. The following is applied:

- A. Flying Skull which contains Citric Acid and is used needed during vegetation.
- B. During vegetative and flower stage we do bring in predatory insects such as nematodes and cucumeris mites as a preventative measure to control pest.
- C. Neem oil during very early stage of veg stage and it is to spot treat since we are using beneficial insects on plants.

WAM Oil actively sources material from the following:

1. Green Barn Farms. Green Barn Farms is a Clean Green Certified farm which is the cannabis equivalent of the USDA's organic standard for produce. Green Barn Farms utilizes organic neem oil preflower to spot treat any pest issues. Once in flower, Green Barn Farms does not utilize any pesticides, but do bring in predatory insects such as lady bugs and predatory mites to control any pest problems.
